

## Scandinavian Star Instructions

This is the easiest method to make your stars. No sewing is required. It is more difficult if you fold your fabric like bias binding and they come out much smaller. Your raw edges will be hidden inside if you follow these instructions. Starching and pressing are very important because fabric will be too soft to hold a fold if not starched and pressed.



1.

Cut 4 – 2 1/2x16" cotton strips



2.

**Starch** and fold in half lengthwise (once)



3.

Lay out 2 vertical and 2 horizontal strips



4.

Fold in half **with a fold on each side!**



5.

Tuck a double strip **inside each fold** and pull snugly



6.

Flip one North to South; one East to West; one South to North and one West to East



7.

Tuck the 4 long strips under the center folds, (like previous side). Pull snugly, again.



8.

Fold North behind and East



9.

Fold East down to South



10.

Fold arrow toward center. Tuck excess inside square. pull snugly. Repeat for all points. Cut excess that is under the tucked sections



11.

Finished. You may add a string to hang your star.
